POLICIES

Telephone - Appointments can be made by calling (843) 723-5499. Leave your name and telephone number on the voicemail and your call will be returned as soon as possible. I can be reached at this number Monday-Friday. Messages left over the weekend will be returned on Monday morning. I use the telephone for scheduling appointments. If issues arise that require a lengthier discussion, it is preferable that we set up a session.

Insurance – I am not on any managed care panels and do not accept insurance. However, I will provide you with an itemized bill that you may submit to your insurance company for reimbursement.

Fees – All outpatient visits must be paid for at the time of the visit. At the time of your outpatient visit, you will be provided with an insurance statement to submit to your insurance company. We cannot accept responsibility for negotiating claims with insurance companies or other persons. You are responsible for payment of your medical care regardless of the status of your claim. Any other financial arrangement must be made with us prior to service.
